

### **J-2 Visa Checklist**

<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Passport</b>	Original passport with at least one blank visa page and valid for at least 6 months.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Passport Copy</b>	One photocopy of data and photo pages of passport.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Application Form</b>	One completely filled <a href="#">Visa Application Form(V. 2013)</a> . Please fill in with the free <a href="#">Adobe Acrobat Reader</a> .
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Photo</b>	One photo which must meet the <a href="#">specific requirements</a> .
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Proof of Legal Status of non-Australian</b>	Non-Australian applicant should have legal status in Australia and a copy of current status proof, such as <a href="#">VEVO</a> , <a href="#">ImmiCard</a> or visa should be submitted.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Previous Chinese passports or Chinese visa</b>	When applying for Chinese visa with a new passport, applicant who used to be of Chinese citizenship should submit the original and a copy of the data page of the last Chinese passport, or a copy of previous Chinese visa on the previous foreign passport. If your name on the current passport differs from that on the previous passport, an official document of name change should also be submitted.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Visa Notification Letter</b>	Visa Notification Letter issued by the Information Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of China or other authorized units in China.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Letter of Media</b>	An official letter issued by the media organization for which the journalist works.
