<input type="checkbox"/>	Passport photocopies	Photocopies of data and photo pages of the passport.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Application form	One completely filled Visa Application Form(V. 2013) . Please fill in with the free Adobe Acrobat Reader .
<input type="checkbox"/>	Photo	One photo which must meet the specific requirements .
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of legal status of non-Australian	Non-Australian applicant should have legal status in Australia and a copy of current status proof, such as VEVO , ImmiCard or visa should be submitted.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Previous Chinese passport or Chinese visa	When applying for Chinese visa with a new passport, applicant who used to be of Chinese citizenship should submit the original and a copy of data page of the last Chinese passport, or a copy of previous Chinese visa on the previous foreign passport. If the name on the current passport differs from that on the previous passport, an official document of name change should also be submitted.
